A very handsome clock in heavy oak case c.1900.

Pleasance and Harper started as a watch and jewellery shop in 1879, trading from Wine Street in Bristol, where this large clock may have come from.

The Company, as it is now, came in to being after the First World War when Mr. Harper's three sons came into the business and expanded the company opening shops throughout Wales, The Midlands and the West Country.
