## AVW Dog Beds

Directly copied from an Edwardian original, currently occupied by Tasciovanus, my Jack Russell terrier, the AVW Dog Bed is 100% hand made in North Wales by expert craftsmen from locally sourced Ash (which gives the beds that fabulous grain) and set on vintage croquet balls.

One size really does cover most breeds; Tasci tends to curl up in a corner ( though he is flat out starfished on his back, true Jack Russell style, once he is asleep) and it is easily suitable to medium labrador/Spaniel size. If a larger bed is still needed then that is easily done at no extra cost just let us know the dimensions you want.

And in the same vein, the natural colour of the Ash is quite light but they can easily be stained to a darker shade of choice.
